

Last Supper

1st Table (Bread)

Afikoman

This is the bread that Jesus broke up and passed onto the disciples. It is the second (middle) piece of the three pieces Matzoh package at the Passover table. The Bible talked about God the father, God the son and God the Holy Spirit. It traditionally must be taken away, found and redeemed.

The Bible said that we are like lost sheep and the good shepherd has found us and bring us back. In addition, Jesus also redeemed us.

Say this prayer in Hebrew and then eat the Matzoh.

Baruch.atah.Adonai.eloheinu.melech.ha-alom.ha-motzi.lechem.min.ha-aretz;
(Blessed.are.you.Lord?King.of.the.universe.who.bring.forth.bread.from.the.earth)

Jesus said when you eat of it, remember me. What do you remember?

2nd Table (Wine)

Cup of Redemption (the third cup)

This is the cup that promised the Jewish people that God is their redemption. Jesus said to his disciples that because of His shed blood this cup provides real instead of symbolic redemption. Before the last supper, they only hope to be redeemed.

Say this prayer in Hebrew and then drink.

Baruch.atah?Adonai.Eloheinu?Melech.haolam?borei.p"ri.hagafen;
(Blessed.are.you.Lord?King.of.the.universe;Creator.of.the.fruit.of.the.vine)

Jesus said when you drink of it, remember me. What do you remember?

3rd Table (Other stuff)

1. Charoset – a mixture of apple, walnut, raisin, honey and cinnamon. It represents the mud they used to make bricks in Egypt. Now that they are set free, it became sweet. Oh, the sweet salvation of God that has been provided for us.
2. Bitter herb – The bitterness as slaves, how they suffered in captivity and prayed for deliverance. When we are suffering, God will hear our prayers and deliver us.
3. Shank Bone – Bible instructed the Israelite not to break any bone of the Passover lamb. Jesus died after three hours on the cross which is an amazingly short amount of time it took. Therefore, the Roman soldiers did not break his bone like what they did to the other two thieves next to Jesus. One powerful proof that Jesus is the Messiah. How many more proof do you know? (Hint-over 100 in the Old Testament). Also, it tells us that Jesus gave up his life and die for our sin. No one else can kill him.
4. Salt water – The tears during captivity. If you remember this, you also treasure the freedom that you have been given. The Bible said you shall know the truth and the truth will set you free. Remember, the amount of freedom corresponds to how much you know the truth, Jesus himself.
5. Roasted Egg – Jewish people used this to symbolize the sacrifices they made in the temple. Since the temple is destroyed, sacrifices are no longer possible. The book of Daniel chapter 9 foretold the Messiah will be cut off and be no more before the second temple is destroyed. Every Jew knows that is on 70 AD. A very powerful prophecy on who is the Messiah. The only person who fulfilled this was Jesus.
